MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS. 988 OPERATORS WILL ASK YOU A FEW QUESTIONS AND RESPOND WITH A SMALL MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS TEAM. THIS IS PREFERRED TO CALLING 911 WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL IS EXPERIENCING A MENTAL CRISIS, AS CALLING 911 IS LIKELY TO RESULT IN AN ARMED RESPONSE. 988 OPERATORS WILL USE YOUR ANSWERS TO DETERMINE IF A POLICE OFFICER SHOULD ACCOMPANY THE MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS TEAM.
